

Join Pastor John Reynolds on a *10 Day Bible Lands Pilgrimage*

Departing November 27, 2017

YOUR DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day 1 - Nov. 27 - We meet at our gateway airport to board the flight for Israel. Dinner will be served on board and breakfast will be served before arrival in Tel Aviv.

Day 2 - Nov. 28 - We arrive in the Holy Land. After passport control, we are met by a greeter from the travel company and welcomed to Israel. Then we will claim our luggage and as a group go to meet our wonderful guide. The guide will lead us to our motor coach and if we have time we will visit Caesarea and Mt. Carmel before arriving at our hotel in Tiberius for dinner and a good night's rest.

Day 3 - Nov. 29 - We awake refreshed and enjoy a full Israeli-buffet breakfast and then go for a memorable boat ride on the Sea of Galilee ending at the Museum of the Ancient Boat. We then visit the newly excavated ruins at Magdala before driving up the Valley of the Dove to the overlook atop the Arbel. We next visit the Wedding Chapel in Cana where the first recorded miracle of Jesus was performed. Couples who wish will have the opportunity to renew their wedding vows in this very special place. We will then visit Nazareth for a tour of Nazareth Village. Driving through the Valley of Armageddon we pass Mt. Tabor and review the great importance of that place and soon come to the stunning ruins of Megiddo. After this good and exciting day we return to our hotel for dinner and a good night's rest.

Day 4 - Nov. 30 - Those who wish may get up a little early for a sunrise service overlooking the Sea of Galilee. After breakfast we head north to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. Next we have a unique visit to the city of Hazor. Now it is on to Tel Dan and the beginning of the Jordan River. Our visit to Caesarea Philippi is always special as we study Peter's confession. After lunch we have an unforgettable drive through the Golan Heights down to the Sea of Galilee to visit Capernaum, "Jesus' Home Town." We finish the day at the Church of the Multiplication where Jesus miraculously fed the 5000. We now go to the hotel for dinner and a night's rest.

Day 5 - Dec. 01 - Moving day! Our bags are packed and outside our doors before breakfast. After making sure our bags are on our motor coach, we board and head to the baptismal site where all who want can be baptized in the same river in which our Lord was baptized. We are now headed to Gideon's Spring to remember that great victory with the 300. The drive past Bet Shean and down the Jordan Valley is a wonderful experience. Near the Dead Sea we come to Jericho and the traditional site of Jesus' baptism. Now we ascend the mountain for a grand entrance into Jerusalem and to our hotel for dinner and our rooms for the next four nights.

Day 6 - Dec. 02 - Today we travel to the lowest place on earth - the Dead Sea. We will learn about the discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls at Qumran, see the area of Ein Gedi, where David hid from King Saul, ascend Masada and "float" in the Dead Sea. This is the only water in the world with this kind of buoyancy. This entire day is a unique experience. Now it is back to the hotel for dinner and a good night's rest.

Day 7 - Dec. 03 - This morning begins at the top of the Mt. of Olives with a view of the Old City and orientation of the final days of Jesus' Ministry before the Crucifixion. This is also the place from where he ascended and where His feet will touch Earth the next time. We will then visit Bethlehem for lunch, shopping and a visit to the Church of the Nativity and the Shepherd's Field. We arrive back in Jerusalem in time for our visit to the Garden Tomb and Golgotha.

Day 8 - Dec. 04 - Beginning this day at the Western Wall we are ready for an early appointment to tour the Western Wall Tunnel. As we exit the tunnel we walk on the Via Dolorosa and enter the 1st and 2nd stations of the cross where Christ was brought before Pilate and was beaten by the soldiers. Next is another high point as we come to the Pool of Bethesda and St. Ann's Church. Our singing in this church will amaze us. We leave the Old City through St. Stephen's Gate and go down to the Kidron Valley to the Garden of Gethsemane. Then we go to Mt. Zion to visit the ancient City of David and the Upper Room. We end our day in the Valley of Elah where David killed Goliath. We again return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 9 - Dec. 05 - This is a glorious day off. Everyone may rest, relax, shop, visit a special attraction of interest to you or just explore Jerusalem on your own. Remember to be back to the hotel in time to get your bags packed and outside your door before our Farewell Dinner. After dinner we make sure our bags are on the bus, then we drive to the airport for our flight home.

Day 10 - Dec. 06 - We say good-bye to our guide and driver and to this wonderful land. We board our flight with many great memories and many new friends and a fresh perspective of the Bible and an overwhelming desire to return to Israel. We fly through the night and arrive back in New York for our connecting flight home.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tour prices: All prices in this brochure are based on airfares, land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 30 passengers or more. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Group IST, LLC (doing business and referred to therein as "Journeys Unlimited"), but an additional charge may apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations, changes in fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments: Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per person deposit plus applicable (optional) insurance. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Balance is due 60 days before departure date. If final payment is received less than 60 days, a late fee will be accessed in the amount of \$50.00. If final payment is made by credit card (American Express, Visa, MasterCard), Journeys Unlimited requires a completed credit card authorization form. All payments made by check should be made payable to Journeys Unlimited.

Late Reservations: If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment plus applicable taxes and optional insurance is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50.00 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services. No personal checks will be accepted with reservations received 30 days or less before departure date. Money order, bank check, certified check or credit cards (American Express, Visa, and MasterCard) will be accepted.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for US passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-US citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non US citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the USA. Journeys Unlimited assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Journeys Unlimited will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation.

Final Documents and Tickets: All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within 3 weeks of departure. Documents and tickets are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

Air from Home City: All brochure departures are based on a New York area airport. Journeys Unlimited can help arrange air transportation from your home city airport. Journeys Unlimited is not responsible for any penalties incurred on domestic tickets not purchased from us, in case of changes in the schedule of the tour. If you are making your own domestic airline tickets, please make sure that your domestic flight time arrives at least 4 hours prior to your international departure time.

Air Changes, Cancellations & Refunds: Airline tickets issued by Journeys Unlimited are highly restrictive and in most instances cannot be reissued, revalidated or exchanged. If a change is possible, a \$75 per person administrative fee, plus any applicable airline change fees, will be assessed once air tickets have been issued. Airline penalties vary depending on carrier.

Airline Seat Assignments and Special Services: There is no advance seat selection. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companions. Seating is solely under control of the airlines. Some airfares used may be eligible for frequent flyer mileage.

Baggage: The company is not responsible for any additional charges collected by the carriers at the airport for luggage fees. We recommend that you take along one suitcase per person with a maximum weight of 50lbs., plus one carry on with maximum dimensions of 9"X14"X22". Airlines also have their own baggage restrictions; please check with the air carrier prior to your departure. All baggage is the passenger's responsibility throughout the tour. Journeys Unlimited is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to your baggage. If a bag is lost or damaged in-flight, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly.

Airline Clause: The airlines concerned will not be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not aboard their aircraft. If a roommate is not available, you must pay the single room supplement. While single rooms provide privacy they are often smaller than twin bedrooms. Triple rooms are available in many hotels for family or friends traveling together. There are no discounts for triple rooms.

If you cancel your tour after you have received your documents and airline tickets, you must return them to Journeys Unlimited before we can process your refund.
